Mr. Dorman Hillie Lott October 20, 1928 – September 13, 2012 Dorman Hillie Lott was born October 20, 1928 in Frostproof, Florida, and passed away in Centre, Alabama on September 13, 2012. Funeral services for Mr. Lott will be Monday, September 17th at 1 pm at Holy Comforter Episcopal Church in Gadsden, where Mr. Lott was a member. Rev. David Barfield will be officiating. The body will lie in state 1 hour prior to service. Burial will follow at Cherokee Memory Gardens with military honors. The family will receive friends 5-7pm Sunday night at the funeral home. Pallbearers will be family and friends. Mr. Lott is survived by his wife of 61 years, Sybil A. Lott; daughters Amy Hurley of Reidsville, GA, and Julia (Andy) Dingus of Watkinsville, GA; grandchildren: Jennifer Beasley, Layla Dingus and Salley Dingus, three great-grandchildren. Mr. Lott was preceded in death by his son, Kenneth F. Lott, and two brothers, Broward and Buford Lott. Mr. Lott served his country in the US Army, the US Air Force, and the US Air Force Reserves. The majority of his service was as an air traffic controller in the US Air Force, from which he retired with the rank of Major. During his military career, he served in Vietnam during war time, and in posts around the world including Alaska, Oregon, and Germany. After retiring from the Air Force, Mr. Lott worked for the US Civil Service, training air traffic controllers in Saudi Arabia. Mr. Lott holds a Bachelors degree in Animal Husbandry from the University of Georgia and a Master's in Business Administration from Florida State University. He has also completed technical courses of study in auto mechanics and auctioneering and the US Air Force

Command and Staff College.
