January 11, 1943 - August 13, 2015

Mr. Edward Mackey age 72 of Leesburg passed away Thursday, August 13th at his residence.

Funeral services will be 3 PM Sunday August 16th at Centre First Baptist Church, with Rev. Melvyn Salter and Dr. David Lee officiating, burial will follow in Mackey Cemetery. The body will lie-in-state at the church one hour prior to service. The family will receive friends from 5 until 8 PM Saturday.
