Hilda Laverne Wine Moody, age 69 of Centre, passed away Saturday, September 19th in Baton Rouge, LA.

Funeral services will be 11 AM Wednesday, September 23rd at Perry Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Eddie Nation and Rev. Melvyn Salter officiating; burial will be 2:30 PM Wednesday in Hopewell Cemetery in Blount County. The family will receive friends from 9 until 11 AM Wednesday.

She was a member of the WMU and its Round Table Group. She was one of the original members and current president of the Cherokee Medical Center Auxiliary. She was the president of the National Association of Retired Federal Employees chapter 1868 in Fort Payne and a member of the Cherokee County Farmer's Federation Women's Committee. She conducted surveys for the Alabama Farmer's Federation Market Basket Report for many years.

Hilda was an avid supporter of Auburn football. She and her husband have been season ticket holders since 1964, missing very few games in 51 years. She has also attended all but one of the last 47 annual meetings of the National Association of County Agricultural Agents.
