Mr. William Jackson (Jack) Morgan Sr. age 95, of Centre passed away Wednesday, December 7th at Cherokee Village Assisted Living Center.

Funeral services will be 11 AM Friday December 9th at Perry Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Melvyn Salter and Dr. Eddie Nation officiating. Burial will follow in Cherokee Memory Gardens. The family will receive friends from 9:30 AM until 11AM at the funeral home.

Mr. Morgan was born in Dawson, AL and graduated from Geraldine High School. After graduation he joined the U.S. Navy where he served as a disbursing officer. After the war ended his ship made two trips to Pearl Harbor and one to Japan transporting troops back home. During his World War II

Naval service he attended the University of South Carolina, Auburn, Bucknell, and Harvard. He also attended the University of Alabama after the war.

He was an accountant and operated his own business for 25 years. One of the things he enjoyed most about his career choice was his retirement plan. He worked during tax season and was an avid gardener the remainder of the year. He worked 67 tax seasons and loved it. He was still preparing taxes at the age of 94. He enjoyed growing vegetables and giving them to his friends and family members.

He was a Christian and member of the First Baptist Church in Centre, where he served as ordained deacon for many years.
