James Dalph Pickelsimer, Cherokee County's oldest World War II veteran passed away Monday, March 9, at the age of 99 in Huntsville, AL.

James served in the US Navy from 1943 – 1946 with the Amphibious Forces of the U. S. Pacific Fleet in the Marshall, Carolina and Marianna Islands. He held the Rank of Ship Fitter 2nd Class with Standard Landing Craft Unit 34.

James retired from the maintenance department of Goodyear Aerospace in Akron, Ohio with 25 years of service. He was a member and deacon of Cedar Bluff First Baptist Church and a member of the Joppa Masonic Lodge in Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio.
