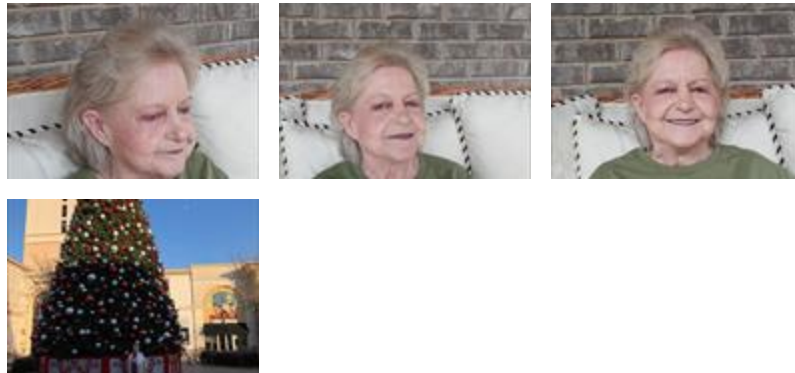
“ Ms Linda was a wonderful lady.. she was good to all of us. She is not sick anymore. I'm sure Anda is keeping her busy.
