



Roy Joseph Bruce

June 6, 1917 - September 4, 2010

Mr. Roy Joseph Bruce, age 93 of Centre, passed away Saturday, September 4th at Cherokee County Health & Rehab. Funeral services will be 3PM Tuesday at Perry Funeral Home Chapel with Dr. Jim Wright and Rev. Melvyn Salter officiating; Entombment will follow in Green Hill Memory Garden Mausoleum. The family will receive friends from 6 until 8 PM Monday, at the funeral home. Pallbearers include Ken Bruce, Kyle Bruce, Bill Chandler, Ken Parker, Alan Moore and Patrick Moore. Mr. Bruce was a native of Chattooga County, GA, the son of the late Guy and Grace Loggins Bruce, and a veteran of WWII. He was CEO and Partner with Chandler Fabric Stores for 33 years and was owner of Mr. Roy's of Leesburg. He was a founding member and served on the Board of Directors of First Tennessee Bank. Mr. Bruce was a member of the Centre First Baptist Church, where he served as Sunday school teacher and trustee. He was also very active with Carpenters for Christ. He was a member of the Lions Club, the Kiwanis Club and the American Legion. He served as area leader of the Boy Scouts of America,

was charter member of the Trion 50 yard club, was past patron of the Order of the Eastern Star, and was a mason. He was a past member of the Trion City Council. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to Centre First Baptist Church ROC.
