Willie Mae Jordan of Centre, Alabama, passed away on March 12, 2024, at the age of 95. She was born on August 15, 1928, in Centre, Alabama to Gus and Etta Mae Rains. A graduate of Cherokee County High School, she moved to Gadsden following her marriage to Leon Jordan.
